Recipe Corner

Chicken Tetrazzini

Ingredients

16 oz. linguini, cooked
½ cup butter, softened
4 chicken breasts, cooked, diced
2 cans cream of chicken soup
2 cups sour cream
1 tsp kosher salt
½ tsp ground pepper
½ cup chicken broth
2 TB parmesan cheese
2 cup shredded mozzarella

Instructions

Cook noodles according to box instructions. Set aside.

In a medium bowl, combine ½ cup butter, cooked chicken, soup, sour cream, salt, pepper and chicken broth. Mix well and then add in cooked noodles.

Spray a 9x13 pan and pour in noodle mixture. Sprinkle cheeses on top. Bake covered with foil for 45 minutes.

This is an old recipe from the 60's.
